RESOLUTION NO. 381 S. 2015

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF A TRUST FUND FOR THE PURPOSE
OF PHILHEALTH REIMBURSEMENTS, ONE TRUST FUND EACH FOR MATERNITY CARE
PACKAGE; TB DOTS BENEFIT PACKAGE; NEWBORN SCREENING PACKAGE; AND
ANIMAL BITE PACKAGE AND THE DISPOSITION OF THESE FUNDS BASED ON
THE EXISTING GUIDELINES GIVEN BY PHILHEALTH IN THEIR CIRCULARS**

WHEREAS, the City Health Officer, Rosanna Carmelita A. Barrion requested for the passage of a resolution authorizing the creation of a trust fund for the purpose of Philhealth reimbursements, one trust fund each for Maternity Care Package; TB DOTS Benefit Package; Newborn Screening Package; and Animal Bite Package;

WHEREAS, the National Health Insurance Act of 2013 prescribes that Philhealth reimbursements to public health facilities be retained by the individual facility and be spent on operating expenses of the facility, as well as improvement of its services. This shall mean that these funds be placed in a trust fund solely for the use of the accredited health facility which shall be used in improving the health services;

WHEREAS, the request of one trust fund each for each package is to efficiently monitor the compliance with the disposition of these funds. The creation of a trust fund is provided for in different circulars of Philhealth.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, as it hereby resolves, to authorize the creation of a Trust Fund for the purpose of Philhealth reimbursements, one trust fund each for Maternity Care Package; TB DOTS Benefit Package; Newborn Screening Package; and Animal Bite Package.



SUBJECT : Letter from the City health Officer, Rosanna Carmelita A. Barrion requesting for the passage of a resolution authorizing the creation of a trust fund for the purpose of Philhealth reimbursements, one trust fund each for Maternity Care Package; TB DOTS Benefit Package; Newborn Screening Package; and Animal Bite Package.

COMMENTS/ RECOMMENDATION:

Referred to the Committee on Laws, Rules and Regulations is the above request for study, comment and recommendation.

One of the priority programs of the Department of Health, in support to the Aquino Health Agenda, is Universal Health Care for all Filipinos, also known as Kalusugang Pangkalahatan (KP). Thus, the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) aims to ensure that all Filipinos have access to quality health services that are efficiently delivered, equitably distributed, fairly financed, and appropriately utilized by an informed and empowered public.


Therefore, the City Health Office has been tapped to be service providers of different packages being offered by PhilHealth. At present, the said office is an accredited Primary Care Benefit Package 1 (PCB 1) provider and has two facilities which provide Maternity care Package. The said office is also applying for accreditation of their TB DOTS facility, Newborn Screening and Animal Bite Center. These accredited facilities have Philhealth reimbursements once the members avail of the services included in the package.

In line with this, the Committee recommends:

2. The approval of the required Resolution hereto attached.




