RESOLUTION NO. 237 S.2017

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE EXPANSION OF TALUMPOK NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL INTO AN INTEGRATED SCHOOL AND REQUESTING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD TO CHARGE THE SCHOOL BUILDING, EQUIPMENT, LEARNING MATERIALS, ELECTRICITY AND THE LIKE NEEDED BY TALUMPOK NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF TALUMPOK NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL TO THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE SPECIAL EDUCATION FUND FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2017

WHEREAS, Section 99, Letter (a) of the Local Government Code of 1991 states:

Section 99. Functions of Local School Boards – The provincial, city or municipal school board shall determine, in accordance with the criteria set by the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, the annual supplementary budgetary needs for the operation and maintenance of public schools within the province, city, or municipality, as the case may be, and the supplementary local cost of meeting such needs, which shall be reflected in the form of an annual school board budget corresponding to its share of the proceeds of the special levy on real property constituting the Special Education Fund and such other sources of revenue as this Code and other laws or ordinances may provide;

WHEREAS, the primary function of the LSB rests on what is called the Special Education Fund (SEF). The SEF accrues from the additional one per cent (1%) on real property tax (RPT) levied by municipal government. The collected funds are under the control of the Local School Board (LSB), which has the sole power to determine the appropriations of the said fund.

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE EXPANSION OF TALUMPOK NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL INTO AN INTEGRATED SCHOOL AND REQUESTING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD TO CHARGE THE SCHOOL BUILDING, EQUIPMENT, LEARNING MATERIALS, ELECTRICITY AND THE LIKE NEEDED BY TALUMPOK NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF TALUMPOK NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL TO THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE SPECIAL EDUCATION FUND FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2017

WHEREAS, basic public education is still largely the responsibility of the central government, delivered through the Department of Education (DepEd), notwithstanding the devolution of many basic services to local government units (LGUs);

WHEREAS, the SEF is allotted by the Local Government Code to the Local School Boards for the operation and maintenance of public schools; construction and repair of school buildings, facilities, and equipment; educational research; purchase of books and periodicals; and, sports development in amounts determined by the Local School Boards themselves;


WHEREAS, the Talumpok National High School finds it very crucial for Senior High School Grades 11 and 12 be established at the newly acquired 1000 square meter lot donated by Mr. Eleiodoro Lontok;

WHEREAS, in line with its expansion, the Talumpok National High School is requesting support on its primary needs such as school building, equipment, learning materials, electricity and the like for the establishment of Talumpok National High School Senior High School.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to support the expansion of Talumpok National High School into an Integrated School and to request the Chairman of the Local School Board to charge the school building, equipment, learning materials, electricity and the like needed by Talumpok National High School for the establishment of Talumpok National High School Senior High School to the Annual Budget of the Special Education Fund for Calendar Year 2017.

APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Batangas City this 22nd day of August 2017.”



COMMITTEE REPORT

SUBMITTED BY : COMMITTEE ON LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS

SUBJECT : Letter from the Honorable City Mayor, Beverley Rose A. Dimacuha regarding the request of Mrs. Miguela B. Dimaano, Principal IV of Talumpok National High School to support their primary needs such as school building, equipment, learning materials, electricity and the like, for the establishment of Talumpok National High School Senior High School.

COMMENTS/ RECOMMENDATION:

Referred to the Committee of the Committee on Laws, Rules and Regulations is the above request for study, comment and recommendation.

First committee hearing was conducted on February 7, 2017 attended by the Chairman and members of the committee and other members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. Also present were the City Budget Officer Elizabeth Q. Delos Reyes, Engr. Sonny Godoy of CPDO, representative from City Treasurer's Office Mrs. Felicidad E. Panganiban, and representatives from DepEd Batangas City Ms. Annalyn D. Eborra and Ms. Ronalie P. Andal.

It was then followed by a second committee hearing on August 17, 2017 attended by the Acting Chairman, member and temporary member of the committee and other members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. Also present were Principal of Talumpok National High School Mrs. Miguela B. Dimaano and Legal Officer of DepEd Batangas City, Atty. Mikko Paolo A. Perez.

On a letter dated January 24, 2017, the Honorable City Mayor forwarded to the Sangguniang Panlungsod the letter request of Mrs. Miguela B. Dimaano, Principal IV of Talumpok National High School dated November 2, 2016 to Mr. Donato G. Bueno, Schools Superintendent to support their primary needs such as school building, equipment, learning materials, electricity and the like, for the establishment of Talumpok National High School Senior High School.

Talumpok National High School finds it very crucial for Senior High School Grades 11 & 12 be established at the newly acquired 1000 square meter lot donated by Mr. Eleiodoro Lontok. Most of Talumpok National High School Junior High School completers are residing in far-flung areas and such issue of distance and costly transportation hinders them from pursuing Senior High School, hence, the establishment of Talumpok Senior High School is the only avenue for students to continue pursuing their studies.

Considering the justifications above, the Committee recommends:

2. The approval of the required Resolution hereto attached.
