**A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE ACCREDITATION OF BATANGAS
COASTAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT FOUNDATION, INC.**

1. Chapter 4. – Relations with People’s and Non-governmental Organizations.
 - 1.1. Section 34. Role of People’s and Non-governmental Organizations. – Local Government Unit shall promote the establishment and operation of people’s and non-governmental organizations to become active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy.
 - 1.2. Section 35. Linkages with People’s and Non-governmental Organizations. – Local Government Units may enter into joint ventures and such other cooperative arrangements with people’s and non-governmental organizations to engage in the delivery of certain basic services, capability-building and livelihood projects, and to develop local enterprises designed to improve productivity and income, diversify agriculture, spur rural industrialization, promote ecological balance, and enhance the economic and social well-being of the people.
 - 1.3. Section 36. Assistance to People’s and Non-governmental Organizations. – A local government unit may, through its local chief executive and with the concurrence of the sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise for economic, socially-oriented, environmental or cultural projects to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction.

WHEREAS, the Committee on Accreditation of the Sangguniang Panlungsod has meticulously reviewed the documents of Batangas Coastal Resources Management Foundation Inc. in order to find out whether the subject NGO is qualified for accreditation and membership in the Local Special Bodies;

WHEREAS, showing substantial compliance with all the necessary and pertinent document for the purpose, it is imperative for the accreditation of Batangas Coastal Resources Management Foundation Inc. by the Sangguniang Panlungsod thru Committee on Accreditation;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session assembled to approved the application for Accreditation of Batangas Coastal Resources Management Foundation Inc. in the City of Batangas.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to recommend the Batangas Coastal Resources Management Foundation Inc. and be given chair as member of the Batangas City Development Council which will assist the Sangguniang Panlungsod in setting direction of economic and social well being of the people and the promotion of ecological balance.

COMMITTEE REPORT

SUBJECT : Application for Accreditation of Batangas Coastal Resources Management Foundation Inc.

The Committee called a Committee Hearing on June 06, 2018 for the purpose of evaluating the qualifications of the applicant for accreditation, and to reiterate the provisions of the Local Government Code and its implementing Rules and Regulations and to provide other clarificatory guidelines relative to the accreditation of people's organizations, non-governmental organizations and other organized groups, and in the selection of their representatives to the local special bodies. In attendance were: Mr. Ramon J. Araneta, Eladio V. Ebreo and Mr. Bernie R. Matibag, the undersigned Chairman of the Committee on Accreditation, and other members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod – Vice Mayor Jun Berberabe, Councilors Oliver Macatangay, Julian Villena, and Nestor Dimacuha. The members of the Committee – Councilors Serge Atienza, and Armando Lazarte. Councilors Glen Aldover and Gerry dela Roca had to attend equally important undertaking, hence they were not able to attend but expressed their conformity with the conduct of the hearing.

The committee hearing revolved around the accreditation of people's organization, non-governmental organizations and similar aggrupations, which focused on the coverage, purpose, accreditation process and requirements and other related guidelines. The Committee finds that the applicant substantially complied with the requirements of the law for accreditation.

The Committee therefore recommends:
