RESOLUTION NO. 192 S. 2018

**A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE ACCREDITATION OF PILIPINAS
SHELL FOUNDATION, INC.**

WHEREAS, presented before the Sangguniang Panlungsod, were pertinent documents of Pilipinas Shell Foundation, Inc., a fully organized and existing in accordance with Philippine Laws, Rules and Regulations with office address at San Isidro Village Phase 1 San Isidro, Batangas City.

WHEREAS, in adherence to the Local Government Code of 1991 as stated below, the following provisions were elucidated among the representatives of Pilipinas Shell Foundation, Inc. during the committee hearing held on June 13, 2018 at the Sangguniang Panlungsod Session Hall that were attended by the members of the said committee and other members of the Council.

1. Chapter 4.– Relations with People’s and Non-governmental Organizations.

- 1.1. Section 34. Role of People’s and Non-governmental Organizations. – Local government units shall promote the establishment and operation of people’s and non-governmental organizations to become active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy.

- 1.2. Section 35. Linkages with People’s and Non-governmental Organizations. – Local government units may enter into joint ventures and such other cooperative arrangements with people’s and non-government organizations to engage in the delivery of certain basic services, capability-building and livelihood projects, and to develop local enterprises designed to improve productivity and income, diversify agriculture, spur rural industrialization, promote ecological balance, and enhance the economic and social well-being of the people.
- 1.3. Section 36. Assistance to People’s and Non-governmental Organization. - A local government unit may, through its local chief executive and with the concurrence of the sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise for economic, socially-oriented, environmental or cultural projects to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction.

WHEREAS, the Committee on Accreditation of the Sangguniang Panlungsod has meticulously reviewed the documents of Pilipinas Shell Foundation, Inc. in order to find out whether the subject NGO is qualified for accreditation and membership in the Local Special Bodies;

WHEREAS, showing substantial compliance with all the necessary and pertinent document for the purpose, it is imperative for the accreditation of Pilipinas Shell Foundation, Inc. by the Sangguniang Panlungsod thru Committee on Accreditation.

NOW THEREFORE, be to resolved, as it is hereby resolved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session assembled to approve as it hereby approves the Application for Accreditation of Pilipinas Shell Foundation, Inc. in the City of Batangas.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to recommend the Pilipinas Shell Foundation, Inc. and be given chair as member of the Batangas City Development Council which will assist the Sangguniang Panlungsod in setting direction of economic and social well being of the people and the promotion of ecological balance.



COMMITTEE REPORT

SUBMITTED BY : The Committee on Accreditation
SUBJECT : Application for Accreditation of Pilipinas Shell Foundation, Inc.

The Committee called a Committee Hearing on June 13, 2018 for the purpose of evaluating the qualifications of the applicant for accreditation, and to the provisions of the Local Government Code Sec. 34, 35 & 36 and it's implementing Rules and Regulations Art.62,63 & 64 and to provide other clarificatory guidelines of DILG Memo Circular relative to the accreditation of people's organizations, non-governmental organizations and other organized groups, and in the selection of their representatives to the local special bodies. In attendance were: Mrs. Olivia Mamisay-Sorio, Ms. Charie Credito, Mr. Pete Javier, the undersigned Chairman of the Committee on Accreditation, and other members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod – Acting Vice Mayor Councilor Aileen Grace A. Montalbo, Councilors Hamilton Blanco, Alyssa Cruz, Oliver Macatangay, Julian Villena, Nelson Chavez and Nestor Dimacuha. The members of the Committee – Councilors Serge Atienza, Armando Lazarte, Glen Aldover and Gerry dela Roca were also present during the hearing.

The committee hearing focused on the accreditation of people's organization, non-governmental organizations and similar aggrupations, on the coverage, purpose, accreditation process and requirements and other related guidelines. The Committee finds that the applicant substantially complied with the requirements of the law for accreditation.

The Committee therefore recommends:
