**INTERPOSING NO OBJECTION TO THE REQUEST OF DODOLON
AMUSEMENT INC. TO OPEN A BRANCH IN THE NEWLY CONSTRUCTED
SHOPWISE AT GRAND TERMINAL BATANGAS CITY**

WHEREAS, the applicant has signified its intention to operate in Batangas City;

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executive endorsed the letter request of Dodolon Amusement Inc. to the Sangguniang Panlungsod dated June 13, 2019;

WHEREAS, the applicant discussed to the Chairman and members of the committee, other members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, and representatives from concerned departments of the city government necessary information relevant to their application;

WHEREAS, the committee hearing that transpired on June 21, 2019 conducted by the Committee on Games and Amusement, Sangguniang Panlungsod members, representatives of the proponent corporation, zoning official of the CPDO and official of the BPLO clarified all matters relevant to the application and lead to the necessary recommendations that the proponents shall comply;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod as one of the fundamental branches of the City Government of Batangas, confirms that it interposes no objection to the application of Dodolon Amusement Inc. in Batangas City provided that the same is in accordance with the city's zoning ordinance and other ordinances setforth by the City of Batangas to protect the general welfare of its constituents;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Batangas in session assembled to interpose, no objection to the request of Dodolon Amusement Inc. to open a branch in the newly constructed Shopwise at Grand Terminal Batangas City, subject to all existing laws, rules and regulations and in compliance to the following conditions to wit:

1. The proponent shall comply with all the requirements of the concerned national and local agencies and all other applicable and necessary provisions of existing laws, rules, ordinance and regulations relative to the operations of the proponent.
2. The proponent shall adhere to its commitment to conduct activities of corporate social responsibilities particularly to its host barangays.
3. The proponent shall settle/pay all the required taxes, fees and charges required and/or to be imposed by the City Government of Batangas.
4. The proponent shall at anytime, even without prior notice, allow authorized city government officials and employees for the sole purpose of conducting an on-the-spot inspection and monitoring.

6. The effectivity of this Resolution of No Objection shall be upon the compliance of the applicant, Dodolon Amusement Inc., to all existing laws, rules and ordinances.
7. The proponent shall be responsible for any activity that will endanger the general welfare, safety and health of not just the residents of its host barangays but its clientele as well and in the event of such incident if proven valid shall cause for the revocation of the permit issued to the proponent and shall immediately cause the termination, cancellation and stoppage of its operation.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the applicants shall obtain a letter of consent/letter of no objection from the Honorable City Mayor Beverley Rose A. Dimacuha.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution be sent to the Local Chief Executive, City Planning and Development Office and Business Permit and License Division and other agencies concerned for information and guidance.





COMMITTEE REPORT

TO: THE HONORABLE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD

SUBJECT: Request of Dodolon Amusement Inc. to open a branch in the newly constructed Shopwise at Grand Terminal Batangas City.

The subject request to open a branch was referred to the Committee on Games and Amusement for its consideration during the Committee Hearing on June 21, 2019. The Committee held a hearing on June 21, 2019 and in attendance were the following:

From Dodolon Amusement: Ms. Rachel J. Ruelos; from CPDO: Engr. Roselyn Berberabe from BPLO: Ms. Beth A. Palo. Also present are the Chairman Coun. Sergie Rex M. Atienza and committee member Coun. Julian Pedro Pastor and some of the members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod the Hon. Vice Mayor Emilio Francisco Berberabe and Councilors Armando C. Lazarte, Karlos Buted, Julian B. Villena, Oliver Macatangay, Nestor Dimacuja, Nelson Chavez and Marjorie Manalo.

FINDINGS:

During the committee hearing, the applicant was reminded of the terms and conditions set forth by the Sangguniang Panlungsod most importantly that of prescribed by existing ordinances with regards to safety and regulations regarding activities that may be inimical to the welfare of children. The applicant concurred and expressed its commitment to adhere to such regulations.

Finally, the applicant was also directed to comply with the requirements and acquire business permits and franchise to operate prior to its operation.
