**GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR HONORABLE BEVERLEY ROSE
A. DIMACUHA TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA)
WITH THE EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT (ECCD) COUNCIL
FOR THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR THE TEN (10) ECCD
DAY CARE CENTERS**

WHEREAS, Section 2 of R.A. 10410, otherwise known as the Early Years Act, has declared a state policy to institutionalize a National System for Early Childhood Care and Development (ECCD) that is comprehensive, integrative and sustainable that will involve multi-sectoral and interagency collaboration at the national and local levels among government, among service providers, families and communities and among the public and private sectors, non-government organizations, professional organizations and academic institutions;

WHEREAS, Section 11 of R.A. 10410 also mandates the ECCD Council for the conversion of Day Care Centers into Child Development Centers;

WHEREAS, as a phase of the process of conversion, the ECCD Council will assist ten (10) Day Care Centers in Batangas City where a National Child Development Center has been established in the form of funding support for instructional materials, renovation/repair/rehabilitation/completion of DCCs, and human resource development of Day Care Workers now known as Child Development Workers and Child Development Teacher;

WHEREAS, the LGU intends to use the funding support for the instructional materials, renovation / repair / rehabilitation / completion of Day Care Centers;



COMMITTEE REPORT

GRANT OF AUTHORITY FOR THE CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT (ECCD) COUNCIL FOR THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR THE TEN (10) ECCD DAY CARE CENTERS

BACKGROUND:

The subject request for the grant of authority for the City Mayor to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) was referred to the Committee on Laws, Rules and Regulations for its consideration during the Regular Session on September 10, 2019. The Committee held a committee hearing on September 17, 2019 and in attendance were the following:

From City Budget Office: Mrs. Elizabeth Q. Delos Reyes; from City Planning and Development Office: Engr. Sonny B. Godoy; from City Treasurer's Office: Mrs. Nila Petronila R. Olivario; from City Accounting Office: Mrs. Sherryl Bool; from CSWDO: Mrs. Mila Española and some of the Sangguniang Panlungsod employees. Also present are the Chairperson Coun. Alyssa Renee A. Cruz and Committee members Coun. Gerardo A. Dela Roca, Coun. Julian B. Villena, Coun. Oliver Z. Macatangay and Coun. Nelson J. Chavez. The Vice Mayor Emilio Francisco A. Berberabe Jr., and other members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod Councilors Councilors Aileen Grace A. Montalbo, Nestor Dimacuha, Karlos Buted, Julian Pedro M. Pastor, Isidra M. Atienza, Maria Aleth Lazarte, and SK Federation President Marjorie A. Manalo were also present.

FINDINGS and RECOMMENDATIONS:

During the committee hearing, some members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod acknowledged the significance of having a Memorandum of Agreement as the foremost requirement of the Early Childhood Care and development (ECCD) Council for the allocation of funds and for the process of conversion of Day Care Centers into Child Development Centers. The ECCD Council also assist ten (10) Day Care Centers in Batangas City where an National Child Development Center has been established in the form of funding support for instructional materials, renovation/repair/rehabilitation/completion of DCCs, and

human resource development of Day Care workers now known as Child Development Workers and Child Development Teacher.

The City Social Welfare and Development Officer clearly discussed that the ECCD Council will provide funding support to the City Government of Batangas amounting to One Million pesos (P1,000,000.00) for the purchase of televisions, materials and resources for the ten (10) Day Care Centers in Batangas City specifically in Soro-soro Ibaba Child Development Center, Balagtas Child Development Center, San Jose Sico Child Development Center, Pallocan East Child Development Center, Ilijan Child Development Center, EBD Child Development Center, Bucal Child Development Center, Alangilan I and II Child Development Center and Sta. Clara Child Development Center.

Finding the request to be beneficial to the City Government, the Committee hereby recommends:


1. The adoption of this Committee Report.
2. The approval of the Resolution hereto attached.
