"BAC RESOLUTION NO. 2021-483"

RECOMMENDING THE USE OF NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT-EMERGENCY CASES AS MODE OF PROCUREMENT FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF GOODS AND COMMODITIES


- WHEREAS, Section 48, Rule XVI Alternative Methods of Procurement of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act" provides that in order to promote economy and efficiency, the procuring entity may resort to any of the alternative methods of procurement which are Limited Source Bidding, Direct Contracting, Repeat Order, Shopping and **Negotiated Procurement**, provided that the most advantageous price for the government will be obtained;
- WHEREAS, Negotiated Procurement under Emergency Cases may be resorted in case of imminent danger to life or property during a state of calamity, or when time is of the essence arising from **natural** or man-made calamities or other cases where immediate action is necessary to **prevent damage to or loss of life or property**, or to restore vital public services, infrastructure facilities and other public utilities;
- WHEREAS, Hon. City Mayor Beverley Rose A. Dimacuha signed Executive Order No. 36 s. 2021 on September 16, 2021, declaring State of Calamity in Batangas City due to Typhoon Jolina;
- WHEREAS, Batangas City has suffered considerable damages in agriculture and infrastructure brought by Typhoon Jolina in different barangays and various areas in the city, hence the move of the city government to distribute canned goods to Batangas City residents directly affected by this typhoon.
- WHEREAS, the Approved Purchase Request (PR) No. 16575 charged under General Fund dated September 17, 2021 for the ***Supply and Delivery of Goods and Commodities to be distributed for the Typhoon Jolina victims as requested by the City Social Welfare and Development Office amounting to Two Million Four Hundred Fifty Six Thousand Three Hundred Fifty (Php2,456,350.00)*** was indorsed to the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC);
- WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee is authorized to resort to Alternative Mode of Procurement in accordance with the provisions of RA 9184, under Section 53.2 (Negotiated Procurement-Emergency Cases) as per approved authority;
- WHEREAS, it appearing that the price offered by **TEN 25 ENTERPRISES** with business address located at **Brgy. Tulo, Batangas City** was found to be the most reasonable and advantageous to the City Government, if accepted;


NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVED as it is Hereby Resolved, to RECOMMEND to the HoPE for the APPROVAL of the AWARD and ACCEPT the offer made by **TEN 25 ENTERPRISES** for the Supply and Delivery of Goods and Commodities in the grand total amount of P2,453,806.00 to wit:


