- WHEREAS, Section 15 Article II of the 1987 Constitution avers that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and **instill health consciousness among them;**
- WHEREAS, as per IATF Resolution, Batangas City is still under the General Community Quarantine with heightened restrictions;
- WHEREAS, Section 48, Rule XVI Alternative Methods of Procurement of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act" provides that in order to promote economy and efficiency, the procuring entity may resort to any of the alternative methods of procurement which are Limited Source Bidding, Direct Contracting, Repeat Order, Shopping and **Negotiated Procurement**, provided that the most advantageous price for the government will be obtained;
- WHEREAS, Negotiated Procurement under Emergency Cases may be resorted in case of imminent danger to life or property during a **state of calamity**, or when time is of the essence arising from **natural** or man-made calamities or other cases where immediate action is necessary to **prevent damage to or loss of life or property**, or to restore vital public services, infrastructure facilities and other public utilities;
- WHEREAS, the Approved Purchase Request (PR) No. 17075, charged under General Fund for the **Refilling of Three Hundred (300) LPG tanks amounting to Two Hundred Seventy Thousand Pesos (Php270,000.00)** as requested by BCIMT Logistics Section/Kitchen Brigade was indorsed to the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), to be used in the food preparation for the frontliners assigned and Covid19 patients confined in city government's temporary health/isolation facilities;
- WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) is authorized to resort to Alternative Method of Procurement in Accordance with the provisions of Section 53.2 of the IRR of RA 9184 (Negotiated Procurement - Emergency Cases) citing the utmost need to save and to prevent damage to or loss of life or property, or to restore vital public services:
- WHEREAS, it appearing that the price offered by **RCBC PETRON GASOLINE STATION** with business address located at Kumintang Ilaya, Batangas City, was found to be the most reasonable and advantageous to the City Government, if accepted;
