"BAC RESOLUTION NO. 2022-SSU

RECOMMENDING AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE RESCUE DIVING FEE THROUGH
NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT (SMALL VALUE PROCUREMENT) AS REQUESTED BY CITY
DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICE, BATANGAS CITY

WHEREAS, the Batangas City Government intends to procure Rescue Diving Training Fee with an Obligated Purchase Request No. 200-2022-08-009652 charged under General Fund dated August 24, 2022 with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) amounting to Two Hundred Ninety Nine Thousand Six Hundred Forty Four Pesos and 80/100 (Php 299,644.80) for the conduct of Rescue Diving Training (Scuba Diving) as requested by City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office;

WHEREAS, Section 48, Rule XVI Alternative Methods of Procurement of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act" provides that in order to promote economy and efficiency, the procuring entity may resort to any of the alternative methods of procurement which are Limited Source Bidding, Direct Contracting, Repeat Order, Shopping and **Negotiated Procurement**, provided that the most advantageous price for the government will be obtained;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) is authorized to resort to Alternative Method of Procurement in Accordance with the provisions of Section 53.9 of the IRR of RA 9184 (Negotiated Procurement-Small Value Procurement) **citing that the amount of goods being procured does not exceed the threshold prescribed by the IRR of RA 9184;**

WHEREAS, on October 07, 2022, the Bids and Awards Committee-Secretariat/TWG for the Procurement of Goods and Services sent Request for Quotation (RFQ's) thru the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (Philgeps) for the procurement of the above mentioned project;

WHEREAS, before the deadline of submission of quotation, only **BALAYAN BAY BOAT INC.** with business address located at Brgy. Poblacion, San Luis, Batangas submitted its quotation;

WHEREAS, upon careful review and evaluation of the requirements submitted, it was found out that the aforementioned supplier sufficiently complied with all the requirements needed which resulted to the following:




WHEREAS, the price offered by **BALAYAN BAY BOAT INC.** was found to be reasonable and advantageous to the City Government, if accepted;
