This declaration capacitated Local Government Units (LGUs) to immediately act to prevent loss of life, utilize appropriate resources to implement urgent and critical measures to contain or prevent the spread of COVID-19, as well as to mitigate its effect and impact to the community;

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act" with its 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) took effect on October 26, 2016 states that the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) is authorized to resort to Alternative Method of Procurement in Accordance with the provisions of Section 53.2 of the IRR of RA 9184 (Emergency Cases) in case of imminent danger to life or property during state of calamity, to save and to prevent damage to or loss of life or property, or to restore vital public services;

WHEREAS, it appearing that the price offered by <u>D' MARINERS INN HOTEL</u> with business address located at <u>Jasmin Rd., Kumintang Ibaba, Batangas City</u> was found to be reasonable and advantageous to the City Government, if accepted;
