

#BAC RESOLUTION NO. 2022 - 101

RECOMMENDING THE USE OF NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT-EMERGENCY CASES AS MODE OF PROCUREMENT FOR THE REFILLING OF LPG TANKS FOR USE OF BCIMT-LOGISTICS SECTION/KITCHEN BRIGADE

WHEREAS, the Batangas City Government intends to procure Refilling of LPG Tanks with an Obligated Purchase Request No. 200-2022-03-002727 dated March 09, 2022 with Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) amounting to Forty Eight Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (Php48,200.00) as requested by Batangas City Incident Management Team-Logistics Section/Kitchen Brigade to be used in the preparation of food to be distributed for frontliners assigned in and Covid-19 patients currently confined in various Temporary Health/Isolation Facilities of Batangas City Government and those isolated/quarantined in their homes;

WHEREAS, Section 15 Article II of the 1987 Constitution avers that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, as per NIATF Resolution, Batangas City is under the Community Alert Level II and still experiencing pandemic;

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued Proclamation No. 922 s. 2020 declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines in view of COVID-19. Under P.P. No. 922, the spread of COVID-19 was considered as an emergency that threatens national security. This declaration capacitated Local Government Units (LGUs) to immediately act to prevent loss of life, utilize appropriate resources to implement urgent and critical measures to contain or prevent the spread of COVID-19, as well as to mitigate its effect and impact to the community;

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act" with its 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) took effect on October 26, 2016 states that the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) is authorized to resort to Alternative Method of Procurement in Accordance with the provisions of Section 53.2 of the IRR of RA 9184 (Emergency Cases) in case of imminent danger to life or property during state of calamity, to save and to prevent damage to or loss of life or property, or to restore vital public services;

WHEREAS, it appearing that the price offered by <u>RBC PETRON GASOLINE STATION</u> with business address located at <u>Kumintang Ilaya</u>, <u>Batangas City</u> was found to be reasonable and advantageous to the City Government, if accepted;

NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVED as it is Hereby Resolved, to RECOMMEND to the HoPE for the APPROVAL of the AWARD and ACCEPT the offer made by **RBC PETRON GASOLINE STATION** in the grand total amount of **P48,000.00** to wit:
