"BAC RESOLUTION NO. 2021-313

**RECOMMENDING THE USE OF NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT-EMERGENCY CASES AS MODE OF
PROCUREMENT FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF VARIOUS MEDICINES TO BE USED IN
BATANGAS CITY TEMPORARY HEALTH FACILITIES**

- WHEREAS, Section 15 Article II of the 1987 Constitution avers that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;
- WHEREAS, the President issued Proclamation No. 1021 s.2020 on September 16, 2020 extending the period of the State of Calamity throughout the Philippines until September 21, 2021 due to the rapid spread of Corona Virus Disease 2019;
- WHEREAS, as per IATF Resolution, Batangas City is still under the General Community Quarantine until July 31, 2021;
- WHEREAS, the Approved Purchase Request (PR) No. 14272 charged under General Fund for the *Supply and Delivery of Various Medicines amounting to Three Hundred Fifty Five Thousand One Hundred Seventy Six Pesos and 35/100 (Php355,176.35)* as requested by City Health Office/BCIMT Medical Response Team to be used in the Temporary Health Facilities of Batangas City Government was indorsed to the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC);
- WHEREAS, As per Republic Act No. 11494 also known as "Bayanihan to Recover As One Act" under Section 4 (Covid19 Response and Recovery Interventions) specifically states that establishment, construction and operation of temporary medical facilities is allowed;
- WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act" with its 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) took effect on October 26, 2016 states that the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) is authorized to resort to Alternative Method of Procurement in Accordance with the provisions of Section 53.2 of the IRR of RA 9184 (Emergency Cases) in case of imminent danger to life or property during state of calamity, to save and to prevent damage to or loss of life or property, or to restore vital public services;
- WHEREAS, upon canvass, it appearing that the price offered by P.A. MENDOZA TRADING AND GENERAL MERCHANDISE with business address located at Apacible St., Batangas City was found to be the most reasonable and advantageous to the City Government, if accepted;

NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVED as it is Hereby Resolved, to RECOMMEND to the HoPE for the APPROVAL of the AWARD and ACCEPT the offer made by P.A. MENDOZA TRADING AND GENERAL MERCHANDISE for the Supply and Delivery of Various Medical Supplies in the grand total amount of P355,072.50 to wit:


