ORDINANCE NO. 22-21 S. 2023

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS OPERATING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF BATANGAS CITY TO INSTALL CLOSED CIRCUIT TELEVISION (CCTV) SYSTEM AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF

SPONSOR : HON. ARMANDO C. LAZARTE
Chairman: Committee on Peace and Order

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the General Welfare Clause of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that "every Local Government Unit shall exercise powers necessary for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essentials to the promotion of general welfare";

WHEREAS, Section 747 and 458 of the same Code provides that the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall "enact and approve ordinances relative to the: (i) maintenance of peace and order, (ii) suppression of lawlessness, and (iii) authorization of the issuance of permits or licenses upon conditions for such purposes intended to promote the general welfare of the inhabitants of the City, regulating thereby any business which does not require government examination within the City and the conditions under which the license for said business may be issued or revoked";

WHEREAS, the Batangas City Police Station has already proven that Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) System is one of the most effective tools in crime deterrence, detection and solution due to a video recording which can be used as evidence in addition to the testimonies of witnesses;

WHEREAS, Batangas City Ordinance No. 27 S. 2012, otherwise known as "An Act Requiring Proactive Measures to be Undertaken for the Peace and Security of Financial Institution, including Pawnshop, Money Changing Shop, and similar Lending Institutions in Batangas City", need to be updated and revised with the aim of expanding the scope which shall include public buildings, schools, local and national government offices and public places, major thoroughfares and intersections in the City of Batangas;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

SECTION 1. TITLE. - This ordinance shall be known as "The Revised CCTV Ordinance of Batangas City".

SECTION 2. OBJECTIVES. - This Ordinance aims to:

- a. Maintain peace and order within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Batangas;

- b. Enhance the capability of the Batangas City Police Station and other Law Enforcement Agencies to improve crime investigations, prevention, detection and solutions thru the use of CCTV recording as evidence to solve criminality;
- c. Provide immediate and timely release of CCTV recording to PNP, Law Enforcement Agencies, local authorities to speed up the criminal investigation.

SECTION 3. SCOPE AND APPLICATION. - The following business establishments are required to install CCTVs including but not limited to;

- a. Financial establishments, banks, pawnshops, money lenders, money remittance services, money changers, and the like;
- b. Business establishments which have several branches in other parts of the country, such as restaurants/fast food chains, 24-hour convenience stores, drug stores and the like;
- c. Shopping malls, shopping centers, supermarkets, talipapa, hospitals, laboratories, clinic and medical facilities, ports, places of entertainment that draw a considerable number of customers/patrons;
- d. Car dealerships, gasoline/fuel refilling stations and vehicle maintenance/service stations;
- e. Public transportation terminal, parking lots and other similar establishments that cater to a large number of vehicles;
- f. All educational establishments in the city, whether private or public, including colleges and universities irrespective of their locations;
- g. All government facilities, courts and office buildings, public markets, plaza and parks, other high-risk areas like warehouses, tourist spots and bypass roads as may be recommended by the Batangas City Police;

- h. Cockpit arenas, basketball court, lumber and hardware store, computer and internet shops and appliance store;
- i. Major thoroughfares, entrance and exit points and intersections in the city;
- j. Religious establishments like churches, house of prayer, mosques and the like;
- k. Other areas which the City Mayor thru the DSS, PNP and TDRO deems proper to have CCTV installed considering the nature of business and potential risks in their respective areas.

The CCTV system shall be maintained in proper working order at all times, and shall be in operation at least during office hours, and shall meet the minimum technological standards set by the ordinance. For this purpose, the Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO) shall be mandated to make a listing and notice of compliance of all business establishments within thirty (30) days after approval of the ordinance.

The City Government of Batangas shall cause the installation of CCTV Camera along major thoroughfares and intersections of the City to augment the security and police work being undertaken by the Batangas City Police Station.

SECTION 4. MINIMUM TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS AND INSTALLATIONS GUIDE. - The CCTV system must be capable of delineating on playback the activity, event and physical features of individuals and areas within the premises, and must be able to record such images on digital, optical or magnetic media.

I. Minimum Technical Requirements.

A. CAMERA. - The camera of the CCTV must meet the following minimum requirements:

- 1. High-definition Analog or at least 2 Megapixel Digital Camera
- 2. 2.8 mm to 3.6 mm focal length
- 3. Auto-Iris Focus lens (Fixed/varifocal)
- 4. 1/30s to 1/50,000s shutter speed
- 5. 50meter in Infrared Range

- 6. 120db wide Dynamic Range
- 7. Pan and Tilt adjustment of 0 degrees to 180 degrees and Rotate adjustment of 0 degrees to 360 degrees
- 8. Outdoor camera must be vandal proof with IP 66 Weather proof casing

B. VIDEO / AUDIO INPUT. - The video/audio input of the CCTV must meet the following minimum requirements:

- 1. Hybrid Type (accepts Digital and Analog Signal)
- 2. Minimum of four (4) camera input
- 3. Video and Audio Stream Input
- 4. Video and Audio Stream Output
- 5. H.264 (Advance Video Coding) Video compression and G0711 u Audio Compression
- 6. 30 frames per second (FPS) recording capability per camera
- 7. Analog High-definition Input (1080 FP, 1080p@, 30 FPS, 720P@ 30 FPS)
- 8. Hard Disk Drive storage system with enough capacity to accommodate the prescribed retention period. (4TB capacity is approximately sufficient for 40 days of recording for DVR with 4 cameras at 1080p)
- 9. Time stamping feature

C. VIDEO / AUDIO OUTPUT. - The video/audio output of the CCTV must meet the following minimum requirements:

- 1. 720p or 1080p resolution
- 2. 30 FPS
- 3. At least 10 megabits per second (Mbps) Video Bitrate and at least 64 kilobits (Kbts) Audio Bitrate

D. OTHER SPECIFICATIONS. - The CCTV must meet the following additional requirements:

- 1. At least (4) cameras covering the areas of transaction and risks when possible, one camera must be facing the street/entrance with the actual number of cameras to depend on the size of the establishment and nature of business, as determined by the LGU.

- 2. Centralized power supply for the video recorder and cameras.
- 3. Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) to provide standards and reasonable back-up power to the video recorder and cameras.

II. INSTALLATION. - Recommended guidelines for the installations of the CCTV System must be complied with by the said proposed Ordinance as follows:

- 1) Cameras must be installed at the secure location with maximum area of coverage of entrance/exits and areas of transaction or risk. Make sure that there will be no blind spots.
- 2) Video recorders must be mounted at concealed locations to protect them upon from deliberate tampering.
- 3) Should not be installed in an area which is not well-lighted at night and must be in an area with consistent lighting to pick-up identifying details such as facial features.
- 4) Consider the angle of the camera to avoid lens phase and backlighting.
- 5) Determine the following objectives and recording distance when installing CCTV Cameras. General surveillance = 10 feet or greater, facial recognition = 5 to 7 feet, plate recognition (For parking Lots) = 3 to 4 feet.
- 6) When possible, a back-up system should be installed alongside the CCTV system to ensure that the data is kept secure in the event of physical harm to the storage devices such as fires, earthquakes, any form of deliberate tampering and other similar situations.
- 7) Upon the discretion of the owner, dummy CCTV Cameras should be placed in a conspicuous area to deter possible criminal acts and protect the cameras.
- 8) Signages/notices indicating that the establishment / area is being monitored by a CCTV System must also be installed in areas that are visible and obvious to the public and must use clear, plain and concise language.
- 9) When possible, at least one staff or employee should be trained to operate / manned the CCTV System.

10) Remote viewing or mirroring is encouraged to be established in an operation control center of such business company.

SECTION 5. PRESERVATION OF THE RECORDINGS. - Video footage obtained through the CCTV systems shall be maintained for not less than thirty (30) days in order to allow investigating authorities to properly retrieve data relevant to any incident under investigation. Upon exceeding the prescribed period, the recordings shall be permanently deleted and the operator, owner and/or manager shall not be liable for its deletion, unless its preservation is required by a court order.

SECTION 6. CONFIDENTIALITY AND NON-DISCLOSURE OF VIDEO RECORDINGS. - The owner and/or manager of the business establishment shall maintain the privacy and confidentiality of the video feeds and recordings obtained as a result of the surveillance performed in accordance with the Ordinance. Toward this end, the owner and/or manager shall prohibit the use, viewing, copying, disclosure or publication of said video feed and recordings for purpose not allowed under the proposed ordinance.

SECTION 7. ACCESS TO FEEDS AND RECORDINGS. - If a crime has been committed or the operator, employee owner and/or manager of the business establishment has reason to believe that a crime has been committed and has been recorded by the CCTV, the operator, employee, owner and/or manager may immediately contact the City Police Station and shall provide immediate access to the pertinent video feeds and recordings to the Police and investigators.

The operator, employee, owner and/or manager of the business establishment shall also make available the camera recordings to the law enforcement authorities engaged in criminal investigations recording upon written request of the authorized or designated officer indicating the particular time and day covered by the requested footage of the CCTV.

The captured video footage or images may be used at any time to satisfy the written order or subpoena of any court or body with competent jurisdiction.

SECTION 8. PRIVACY OF INDIVIDUALS. - The viewing of recorded or captured video footage or images shall be made with due respect to the privacy of individuals. The installation of CCTV cameras in any restroom, toilet, shower, bathroom, changing room and other similar areas shall be prohibited.

SECTION 9. IMPLEMENTING OFFICES. - The Defense Security Services (DSS) shall be responsible for the verification and determination of the relevant business establishment's compliance with this Ordinance. Compulsory inspection of the installed CCTVs shall be conducted by the BPLO, DSS and with the assistance of the City Police Station before the issuance of Certificate of Compliance (COC). The Certificate of Compliance (COC) shall be mandatory requirement for the issuance or renewal by the BPLO and CEO of a business permit or license.

The DSS may conduct inspection during reasonable hours on business establishments that have already complied twice every year without prior notice to ensure that the CCTV System is operational and well maintained. The DSS shall coordinate with and seek assistance of the City Police Station in this regard.

The DSS shall be primarily in-charge for monitoring of the business establishments, schools and government offices in ensuring full compliance of the Ordinance. Furthermore, DSS shall map every camera designated in every critical area and shall regularly check the same every after six (6) months.

Within thirty (30) days from the effectivity of this ordinance, the DSS, BPLO and in consultation with the City Legal Office, shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations to implement this ordinance.

SECTION 10. EXCEPTIONS. - All establishments which at the time of effectivity of this Ordinance, already have existing CCTV System and with the same specification under this ordinance shall be considered compliant with this Ordinance.

SECTION 11. FAILURE TO COMPLY. - Non-compliance of this Ordinance shall be ground for the non-issuance or non-renewal of the business permit of the establishment.

SECTION 12. EMPOWERMENT OF BARANGAY. - All one hundred five (105) Barangays of Batangas City, under the leadership of their respective Punong Barangay, are hereby enjoined to give their full support to adopt this CCTV System in their respective barangay.

SECTION 13. APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS. - The City Government of Batangas shall allocate funds necessary for the effective implementation of this Ordinance including the training of ICT staff.

SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE PERIOD. - All establishments covered by this Ordinance shall comply with the provisions hereof within six (6) months from the effectivity hereof.

SECTION 15. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. - If for any reason, any section of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other sections which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 16. REPEALING CLAUSE. - All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance are vested at the time of the effectivity of this ordinance shall be impaired.

SECTION 17. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. - This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the cities and province of Batangas.



SUBJECT : **AN ORDINANCE MANDATING BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS OPERATING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF BATANGAS CITY TO INSTALL CLOSED-CIRCUIT TELEVISION (CCTV) SYSTEM AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF**

DISCUSSIONS AND OBSERVATIONS

After a careful scrutiny of the ordinance of all present during the Committee hearing, the following revisions were made to wit:

SECTION 1. TITLE

- ❖ Since the Penalty Clause was removed, the committee suggested that the title be modified. The phrase "Prescribing Penalties for Violations Thereof" will be changed to "*Providing Funds Thereof*".

SECTION 3. SCOPE AND APPLICATION

- ❖ Include the religious establishments such as churches, house prayers mosques and the like on paragraph 3(k). Courts and basketball courts shall also be included on this Section.
- ❖ Under Scope and Application, add the phrase "*including but not limited to*" after the phrase "to install CCTVS".
- ❖ The committee suggested that there is a need to submit the lay-out or simple plan as to where the CCTV system will be installed.
- ❖ In paragraph 3(j), delete the phrase "business establishment which the Sangguniang Panlungsod" and change to "*areas which the City Mayor thru DSS, PNP and TDRO*"
- ❖ On the second to the last paragraph, change the word "maximum" to "*minimum*".
- ❖ Delete the last sentence "*Appropriations for this purpose shall be given priority in the allocation of funds in the current or succeeding annual or supplemental budgets of the City*", as this should be discussed on a separate meeting because this was a different subject.
- ❖ The Assessor's Office was directed not to put an additional value in property tax to those establishments and areas mentioned in the Ordinance and shall be exempt from fees and charges that may be imposed.

SECTION 4. MINIMUM TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS AND INSTALLATION GUIDE

- ❖ Indicate the specifications and design of the system which will be submitted to the City Engineer's Office for approval.
- ❖ If possible, categorize the big establishments and areas and require them to install a high-definition CCTV System.
- ❖ Under INSTALLATION, the phrase "provided by" was suggested to "*complied with*".
- ❖ Bullet number 7, change the phrase "When possible" to "*Upon the discretion of the owner*".

SECTION 9. IMPLEMENTING OFFICES

- ❖ Aside from BPLO, the CEO must also be included as an approving office for the issuance or renewal of the business permit or license.

SECTION 10. EXCEPTIONS

- ❖ Delete the "*one (1) year depreciation period*".
- ❖ The committee suggested deleting the SECTION 12. PENALTIES since non-compliance of the Ordinance shall be subjected to non-issuance or non-renewal of the business permit.

SECTION 12. FUNDING REQUIREMENTS

- ❖ "FUNDING REQUIREMENTS" will be changed to "*APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS*".
- ❖ The phrase "amount of three million pesos" will be changed to "*sufficient amount or amount necessary*" for the installation of the CCTV.
- ❖ There was a question on Appropriations on how the subject is going to be implemented.

Deleting SECTION 13. REPEALING PROCESS, since there was no more Penalty Clause.

To add another Provision stating that "Non-compliance of the Ordinance shall be ground for the non-issuance or non-renewal of the business permit.

RECOMMENDATIONS

In accordance with the proceedings and based on the observations and discussions during the Committee Hearing, the Committee on Peace and Order and Public Safety propose the following recommendations:

1. The adoption of this Committee report, and
2. The approval of the attached Ordinance for second and final reading.
