
DECLARING THE REVISED ANNUAL INVESTMENT PLAN OF THE



COMMITTEE REPORT

SUBMITTED BY : THE COMMITTEE ON LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS

SUBJECT : Letter from the Honorable City Mayor, Eduardo B. Dimacuha dated May 13, 2014 endorsing the revised Annual Investment Plan of the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council.

COMMENTS:

The Annual Investment Plan of the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council for CY 2014 amounting to thirty million three hundred eighty-nine thousand and eight hundred nineteen pesos (Php 30, 389, 819.00) was previously approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod last March 31, 2014 since the Committee found that the same was in accordance with law and responsive to the needs of Batangas City. However, last May 13, 2014 a revised City Disaster Risk Reduction Plan and Program CY 2014 was forwarded to the Sanggunian for approval. The Revised AIP includes two (2) additional projects labelled as Construction of Sea Wall with Pier at Liponpon with a resource draft estimate of Php 2, 417, 145.00 and Construction of Drainage System at Balete with a resource draft estimate of Php 1, 668, 000.00.

Section 12, Letter C (7) of R.A. 10121 ("Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010") and Rule 6, Section 4 (8) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. 10121, provide that the CDRRM shall "Prepare and submit to the local sanggunian through the LDRRMC and the LDC the annual LDRRMO Plan and Budget, the proposed programming, resources, funding sources and budgetary support". What is required by the aforementioned law and its IRR is merely the submission of the annual LDRRMO Plan and Budget to the Sanggunian. Hence, the CDRRMO has already complied with the mandate of R.A. 10121.


RECOMMENDATION:

Finding the proposed CDRRMC Annual Investment Plan in accordance with law and responsive to the needs of Batangas City in terms of disaster risk reduction / protection, the Committee recommends:

1. The adoption of this Committee Report
2. The approval of the required Resolution hereto attached.

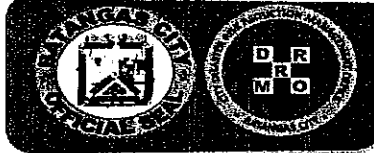
