**RESOLUTION NO. 387 S. 2015**

**A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BATANGAS TO ADOPT THE  
TECHNO GABAY PROGRAM (TGP) IN ITS AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION PROGRAMS  
AND PROJECTS AND ESTABLISH A FARMER’S INFORMATION AND TECHNOLOGY  
SERVICES (FITS) CENTER**

**WHEREAS**, the City Government of Batangas, by virtue of the Decentralization Law under the Local Government Code, must provide agricultural extension and on-site research services and facilities through transfer of appropriate technology and assistance to farmers and other agricultural stakeholders in the city;

**WHEREAS**, by virtue of Executive Order 801 of 2009 the National Government encourages all Local Government Units in the city/municipal and provincial levels to adopt the Techno Gabay Program as an extension delivery services modality and the concerned government agencies to provide the required assistance for the purpose;

**WHEREAS**, the TGP aims to develop, validate and promote an effective mechanism for agriculture and fisheries extension, strengthen the link among technology generators, servers and adoptors, promote and enhance the utilization of technologies in production, post harvest handling, and link clients and development partners to the scientists/experts in the field of agriculture, environment and natural resources;

**WHEREAS**, the TGP with its four components, namely, the Farmer’s Information and Technology Services (FITS) the Magsasaka Siyentista (MS), the Information, Education and Communication (IEC) and the Information and Communications Technology (ICT) shall provide a venue for technology adoption and utilization and source of feedback from clients;

**WHEREAS**, Batangas City, amidst its rapid economic development, gives equal importance to agricultural advancement;




