RESOLUTION NO. 115 S. 2016

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ACCREDITATION OF METRO
BATANGAS BUSINESS CLUB, INC.**

WHEREAS, presented before the Sangguniang Panlungsod, were papers of the Metro Batangas Business Club, Inc. for accreditation purposes;

WHEREAS, in adherence to the Local Government Code of 1991 as reiterated below, the following provisions were elucidated among the representatives of the Metro Batangas Business Club, Inc. during the committee hearing held on May 25, 2016 at the Sangguniang Panlungsod Session Hall that were attended by the members of the said committee and other members of the Council.

1. Chapter 4. – Relations with People’s and Non-governmental Organizations.
 - 1.1. Section 34. Role of People’s and Non-governmental Organizations. – Local government units shall promote the establishment and operation of people’s and non-governmental organizations to become active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy.
 - 1.2. Section 35. Linkages with People’s and Non-governmental Organizations. – Local government units may enter into joint ventures and such other cooperative arrangements with people’s and non-governmental organizations to engage in the delivery of certain basic services, capability-building and livelihood projects and to develop local enterprises designed to improve productivity and income, diversify agriculture, spur rural industrialization , promote ecological balance, and enhance the economic and social well-being of the people.
 - 1.3. Section 36. Assistance to people’s and Non-governmental organization. – A local government unit may, through its local chief executive and with the concurrence of the sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise for economic, socially-oriented, environmental or cultural projects to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction.

UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Batangas City this 30th day of May, 2016.”


