COMMITTEE REPORT

PROPOSED BATANGAS CITY ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) FOR FY 2020

BACKGROUND:

The subject request for the passage a resolution approving the Annual Investment Program (AIP) for FY 2020 was referred to the Committee of the Whole chaired by the Committee on Appropriations for its consideration during the Regular Session on September 10, 2019. The Committee held a hearing on September 16, 2019 and in attendance were the following:

From City Budget Office: Mrs. Elizabeth Q. Delos Reyes; from City Planning and Development Office: Engr. Sonny B. Godoy; from City Treasurer's Office: Mrs. Nila Petronila R. Olivario; from City Accounting Office: Mrs. Sherryl Bool; and some of the Sangguniang Panlungsod employees. Also present are the Chairperson of the Committee on Appropriations Coun. Alyssa Renee A. Cruz and committee members Coun. Julian Villena, Coun. Gerardo A. Dela Roca, Coun. Oliver Macatangay and Coun. Nelson Chavez. The Vice Mayor Emilio Francisco Berberabe Jr. and other members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod Councilors Aileen Grace A. Montalbo, Nestor Dimacuha, Karlos Buted, Julian Pedro M. Pastor, Isidra M. Atienza, Maria Aleth Lazarte, and SK Federation President Marjorie A. Manalo were also present.

COMMENTS:

During the committee hearing, the City Planning and Development Officer discussed a brief background regarding the Proposed Annual Investment Program (AIP) of the Batangas City Government for Fiscal Year 2020. He made mentioned that this proposed AIP was already discussed during the meeting of City Development Council on August 15, 2019. He also cited that as per the Local Government Code of 1991, it was stated that the City Budget for 2020 should be approved on or before October 16, 2019. Some of the concerns raised was the appropriations under the General Public Services relating to the allotted site or property for impounded cars in which members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod considered to also have enough space, facilities and necessary improvements. It was then addressed by the City Planning and Development Officer that it is already considered by the Local Development Council, the identification of the actual site for the said purpose. However, as of the moment, the site were not yet identified.

Other concerns were about the Economic Services specifically the allocation for engineering services which was then addressed by the City Planning and Development Officer that it includes special technical studies like boring test and tests for water supply projects.
