RESOLUTION NO. 329 S. 2019

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ACCREDITATION OF COUPLES FOR
CHRIST (CFC ARCHDIOCESE OF LIPA)**

WHEREAS, presented before the Sangguniang Panlungsod, were papers of **COUPLES FOR CHRIST (CFC ARCHDIOCESE OF LIPA)** for accreditation purposes;

WHEREAS, in adherence to the Local Government Code of 1991 as reiterated below, the following provisions were elucidated among the representatives of **COUPLES FOR CHRIST (CFC ARCHDIOCESE OF LIPA)** during the committee hearing held on September 16, 2019 at the Sangguniang Panlungsod Session Hall that were attended by the members of the said committee and other members of the Council.

1. Chapter 4. – Relations with People’s and Non-governmental Organizations.
 - 1.1. Section 34. Role of People’s and Non-governmental Organizations. – Local government units shall promote the establishment and operation of people’s and non-governmental organizations to become active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy.
 - 1.2. Section 35. Linkages with People’s and Non-governmental Organizations. – Local government units may enter into joint ventures and such other cooperative arrangements with people’s and non-governmental organizations

Continuation of Resolution No. 329 S. 2019

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ACCREDITATION OF COUPLES FOR CHRIST (CFC ARCHDIOCESE OF LIPA)

to engage in the delivery of certain basic services, capability-building and livelihood projects, and to develop local enterprises designed to improve productivity and income, diversify agriculture, spur rural industrialization, promote ecological balance, and enhance the economic and social well-being of the people.

- 1.3. Section 36. Assistance to People’s and Non-governmental Organization. – A local government unit may, through its local chief executive and with the concurrence of the Sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise for economic, socially-oriented, environmental or cultural projects to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction.

WHEREAS, the Committee on Accreditation of the Sangguniang Panlungsod has scrutinized the papers of COUPLES FOR CHRIST (CFC ARCHDIOCESE OF LIPA) in order to find out whether this NGO is qualified for accreditation and membership in the Local Special Bodies;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod thru the Committee on Accreditation has approved the accreditation COUPLES FOR CHRIST (CFC ARCHDIOCESE OF LIPA) as accredited NGO in the Sangguniang Panlungsod, after having found to have complied with all the necessary requirements for this purpose, to wit:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED TO APPROVED, AS IT IS HEREBY APPROVES, the Application for Accreditation of COUPLES FOR CHRIST (CFC ARCHDIOCESE OF LIPA) in the City of Batangas.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that all documents attached hereto made integral parts of this resolution and that copies of this resolution be furnished to COUPLES FOR CHRIST (CFC ARCHDIOCESE OF LIPA) for their guidance and information.

COMMITTEE REPORT

SUBMITTED BY : The Committee on Accreditation
SUBJECT : Application for Accreditation of **COUPLES FOR CHRIST (CFC ARCHDIOCESE OF LIPA)**

The Committee called a Committee Hearing on September 16, 2019 for the purpose of evaluating the qualifications of the applicant for accreditation, and to reiterate the provisions of the Local Government Code and its implementing Rules and Regulations and to provide other clarificatory guidelines relative to the accreditation of people's organizations, non-governmental organizations and other organized groups, and in the selection of their representatives to the local special bodies. In attendance were: The representative of the applicant COUPLES FOR CHRIST (CFC ARCHDIOCESE OF LIPA) Mr. Jaime Fernandez (mission support head) Mr. Cris Soriano (pastoral formation head) and Gay Marie Macalintal - representative from City Planning and Development Office. The undersigned Chairman of the Committee on Accreditation, and other members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod - Councilors Julian B. Villena, Maria Aleth Lazarte, Marjorie Manalo (*SK Fed President*), Nelson J. Chavez, Alyssa Cruz, Oliver Z. Macatangay, The members of the Committee - Councilors Julian Pedro M. Pastor, Isidra M. Atienza, Gerardo dela Roca, Karlos Buted and Nestor Boy E. Dimacuha as temporary member.

The committee hearing revolved around the accreditation of people's organization, non-governmental organizations and similar aggrupations, which focused on the coverage, purpose, accreditation process and requirements and other related guidelines. The Committee finds that the applicant substantially complied with the requirements of the law for accreditation.

- (b) The approval of the resolution hereto attached.






