RESOLUTION NO. 331 S. 2019

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ACCREDITATION OF SAN JOSE SICO LANDFILL MULTIPURPOSE COOPERATIVE

WHEREAS, presented before the Sangguniang Panlungsod, were papers of SAN JOSE SICO LANDFILL MULTIPURPOSE COOPERATIVE for accreditation purposes;

WHEREAS, in adherence to the Local Government Code of 1991 as reiterated below, the following provisions were elucidated among the representatives of SAN JOSE SICO LANDFILL MULTIPURPOSE COOPERATIVE during the committee hearing held on September 16, 2019 at the Sangguniang Panlungsod Session Hall that were attended by the members of the said committee and other members of the Council.

- Chapter 4. Relations with People's and Non-governmental Organizations.
 - 1.1. Section 34. Role of People's and Non-governmental Organizations. Local government units shall promote the establishment and operation of people's and non-governmental organizations to become active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy.
 - 1.2. Section 35. Linkages with People's and Non-governmental Organizations. Local government units may enter into joint ventures and such other cooperative arrangements with people's and non-governmental organizations

to engage in the delivery of certain basic services, capability-building and livelihood projects, and to develop local enterprises designed to improve productivity and income, diversify agriculture, spur rural industrialization, promote ecological balance, and enhance the economic and social well-being of the people.

1.3. Section 36. Assistance to People's and Non-governmental Organization. – A local government unit may, through its local chief executive and with the concurrence of the Sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise for economic, socially-oriented, environmental or cultural projects to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction.

WHEREAS, the Committee on Accreditation of the Sangguniang Panlungsod has scrutinized the papers of SAN JOSE SICO LANDFILL MULTIPURPOSE COOPERATIVE in order to find out whether this NGO is qualified for accreditation and membership in the Local Special Bodies;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod thru the Committee on Accreditation has approved the accreditation of SAN JOSE SICO LANDFILL MULTIPURPOSE COOPERATIVE as accredited NGO in the Sangguniang Panlungsod, after having found to have complied with all the necessary requirements for this purpose, to wit:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED TO APPROVED, AS IT IS HEREBY APPROVES, the Application for Accreditation of SAN JOSE SICO LANDFILL MULTIPURPOSE COOPERATIVE in the City of Batangas.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that all documents attached hereto made integral parts of this resolution and that copies of this resolution be furnished to SAN JOSE SICO LANDFILL MULTIPURPOSE COOPERATIVE for their guidance and information.
