### RESOLUTION NO. 346 S. 2019

A RESOLUTION CONVEYING PROFOUND RECOGNITION AND GRATITUDE TO ALL TEACHERS OF BATANGAS CITY AS THEY CONSTANTLY FULFILL THEIR NOBLE VOCATION IN PERSISTENTLY CRAFTING AND EMPOWERING LEARNERS AMID MODERN DAY CHALLENGES, PURSUANT TO THE NATIONAL TEACHERS MONTH AND WORLD TEACHERS DAY, AND FURTHER RECOMMENDING TO THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD TO EXPLORE THE POSSIBILITY OF UNDERTAKING MEASURES TO INCREASE THE BENEFITS OF OUR PUBLIC ELEMENTARY, SECONDARY AND COLLEGE SCHOOL TEACHERS

WHEREAS, by virtue of Presidential Proclamation No. 242 institutionalized the National Teachers Month that shall be celebrated every 5<sup>th</sup> of September that coincides the United Nations Education, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO)as the "World Teachers Day" that is on the 5<sup>th</sup> of October;

WHEREAS, on September 03, 2015, the Department of Education issued Memorandum No. 99, S. 2015 pertaining to the 2015 National Teacher's Month and World Teacher's Day Celebrations pursuant to the latter that prescribes guidelines relative to the said celebration with this year's theme "Gurong Pilipino: Handa sa Makabagong Pagbabago," highlighting the "indispensability" of teachers especially in keeping the "humanistic aspects of education" in the midst of digital age;
