**RESOLUTION NO. 409 S. 2019**

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE NATIONWIDE VACCINATION AGAINST  
POLIO, IN TAKING NECESSARY MEASURES TO PREVENT ITS TRANSMISSION  
AND PROLIFERATION AND PROMOTING POLIO PREVENTION EDUCATION  
AMONG THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF BATANGAS**

**WHEREAS**, the City Government of Batangas adheres to Section 15, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution state shall promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

**WHEREAS**, polio or poliomyelitis is a “crippling and potentially deadly infectious disease caused by polievirus” spreads from person to person, invading an infected person’s nervous system, causing irreversible paralysis;

**WHEREAS**, since year 2000, the Philippines was declared as polio-free country through efforts of widespread vaccination and strict regulations to prevent the spread of infectious disease;

**WHEREAS**, last September 2019, the Department of Health announced an outbreak of polio in the Philippines which calls for an urgent action to protect more children from being infected;

**WHEREAS**, the City Government of Batangas in support of the nationwide comprehensive vaccination of the Department of Health which serves as a reminder of the importance of increasing immunization coverage to 95% of children to stop polio virus transmission in the country specially in our city;

**WHEREAS**, full immunization can protect children of Batangas City from virus and prevent further transmission of the disease in our city;

**WHEREAS**, in support for the nationwide vaccination against polio, the children/infants of Batangas City are encouraged to undergo immunization programs being implemented by the Department of Health through the Batangas City Health Office;

**WHEREAS**, vaccination is the best and only protection against polio;

**WHEREAS**, terminating the current existence of the disease (polio) is not sufficient the same shall likewise be prevented from recurring by employing all possible measures to hinder its recurrence and to educate the public about polio prevention;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session assembled to urge the people/citizen of Batangas City to support the nationwide vaccination against polio to take all the necessary measures to prevent its further transmission and proliferation and to promote polio prevention education among constituents.
