**RESOLUTION ALLOWING WASTECON INC. TO SECURE ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A TREATMENT STORAGE AND DISPOSAL (TSD) FACILITY IN BARANGAY SAN JOSE SICO, BATANGAS CITY, IN LINE WITH THEIR PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A WASTE TO ENERGY PLANT**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of R.A. 7160 states that every local government unit shall exercise the power expressly granted for its efficient and effective governance which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare, including support to promote health and safety;

**WHEREAS**, developing a treatment, storage and disposal (TSD) facility is comparable to the concept of Waste to Energy (WTE) technology;

**WHEREAS**, DENR expert believes that Waste to Energy (WTE) technology is more environment friendly than sanitary landfill as it leaks methane and other greenhouse gases that have negative effects on environment and health;

**WHEREAS**, securing Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) is imperative, prior to the development of any facilities with environmental significance;





### COMMENTS:
