**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RE-ENGINEERED CITIZEN’S CHARTER OF

WHEREAS, in a letter dated December 4, 2019, the Honorable City Mayor Beverley Rose A. Dimacuha forwarded to the Sangguniang Panlungsod the Re-Engineered Citizen’s Charter of Batangas City Government for adoption;

WHEREAS, R.A. 9485, also known as the Anti-Red Tape Act (ARTA) requires Citizen’s Charter to be displayed in government services offices so that clients can easily check if they are being served according to proper standards;

WHEREAS, the said documents is also a requirement for submission to the Department of Interior and Local Government in compliance with R.A. 11032 or the Ease of Doing Business/Ease of Doing Government Services;

WHEREAS, the said Citizen’s Charter can help improve the delivery of government services to the public including all the requirements, processes and time to secure a certain documents or transactions;

WHEREAS, the continuous and firm commitment, solid cooperation and full support of all department of the City Government and other agencies are necessary for the pursuance of City’s progress and development;


