



**COMMITTEE REPORT**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES FOR LOAN/STANDBY CREDITS FACILITY**

**COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS**

The subject request for the passage of a resolution was referred to the Committee on Appropriations for its consideration during the Regular Session on November 24, 2020.

The Committee held a hearing on December 3, 2020 and in attendance were the following:

From City Treasurer's Office: Mrs. Astler P. Marasigan; from CPDO: Engr. Norberto A. Carandang; from City Accounting Office: Mrs. Sherryl Bool and from Development Bank of the Philippines: SAVP Violeta A. Dela Torre and Mrs. Melissa Joy Patina. Also present are the Chairperson Coun. Alyssa Renee A. Cruz and the committee members: Coun. Gerardo Dela Roca, Coun. Julian Villena, and Coun. Nelson J. Chavez. The Vice Mayor Emilio Francisco Berberabe Jr. and other members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, Councilors Aileen Grace A. Montalbo, Nestor Dimacuha, Karlos Buted, Isidra M. Atienza, and SK Federation President Marjorie A. Manalo were also present.

During the committee hearing, concerns regarding the 2% subsidy for LGU has been asked by a member of the Committee since it was mentioned previously by the Land Bank of the Philippines (LBP) for the Omnibus Term Loan Facilities. Representative from the Development Bank of the Philippines (DBP) then explained that in the implementing rules and regulations of both banks, they incorporated a certain statements that the grant of interest subsidy shall be made by one (1) bank only. It was also reiterated that based on the common terms and conditions of LBP and DBP, a 4% interest rate per annum were offered that will last until December 2022 for two (2) years and then on the 4% interest, the LGU will have the 2% subsidy coming from the national government, in brief, only 2% will be paid by the borrower.

Considering the justifications above and finding the said request in accordance with law and responsive to the needs of Batangas, the Committee hereby recommends:

1. The adoption of this Committee Report.
2. The approval of the required Resolution hereto attached.
