SUBJECT : EXPLORATORY MEETING TO FIND STRATEGIC MEASURES TO AVERT THE AGGRAVATING TRAFFIC SITUATIONS ALONG BRGY. BALAGTAS, ALANGILAN & BRGY. KUMINTANG ILAYA CAUSED BY THE ON-GOING REBLOCKING ACTIVITIES UNDER THE RESPONSIBILITY OF DPWH 2nd DISTRICT.

Sir/Mesdames:

Acknowledging the hullabaloo of the general public, the committee alacrity calls for the aforementioned subject for scrutiny.

Present during the hearing are members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod & the Committee on Transportation namely Councilors Nelson J. Chavez, Karlos Emmanuel A. Buted, Lorenzo A. Gamboa Jr., and Oliver Z. Macatangay. Also, present are Councilors Atty. Alyssa Renee C. Atienza, Aileen Grace A. Montalbo, Isidra M. Atienza, Maria Aleth A. Lazarte, Michael Thomas Pastor, Gerardo A. Dela Roca, and Marjorie A. Manalo. Also present are TDRO Head Engr. Francisco Beredo and Representatives from DPWH 2nd District Engr. Ronald Frago and Engr. Magnaye.

The undersigned explained that the main purpose and objective of the above subject is not to point finger, blame, or find faults and fan the predicament but to find best strategies to be employed to address and solve the concerns of the general public regards the aggravating traffic situation for a better and sound traffic management.

Without a doubt, TDRO are working very hard to continuously improve the traffic situation. Hence, The Committee recognize the importance of unified coordination among TDRO and DPWH to satisfactorily create strategic arrangement and procedures to address the looming concerns and predicament anent the on-going road re-blocking activities.

After thorough and meticulous study of the present situation, the Committee humbly suggest the following measures to hasten and fast track the on-going activities along the national highway stretching from Brgy. Balagtas, Alangilan, and Brgy. Kumintang Ilaya to wit:

For DPWH:

1. Use Early Strength Concrete design.

Using Early Strength Concrete design is imperative. The Early Strength Concrete after pouring will settle in 3 to 6 hours - time and the same can be passable.

2. Advise the Contractor to deploy additional essential equipment for the activities and expand the location area of the activities.

Additional activities and expanding the area will maximize the timeline of activities ahead of the schedule or duration of the project.

3. Compliance to Republic Act 11058, otherwise known as Occupational Safety and Health Standard Act.

This concerns the safety of the worker and the general public as a whole.

4. Upgrading and updating of the DPWH 2nd District Facebook Account anent future, on-going projects within their jurisdiction.

For TDRO:

Request the assistance of the barangay government affected by the aggravating situation. The deployment of Barangay Tanod /s to augment the measly number of TDRO Personnel deployed and manning the traffic flow along the area of their jurisdiction.

In view of the foregoing, the Committee recommends the following:

1. Compliance and adherence to the suggestions stated in the report, however non-compliance ipso facto cease and desist shall be issued.
2. Adoption of the Committee Report.
