THE CITY GOVERNMENT'S COVID-19 RESPONSE-RELATED PROGRAMS
AND PROJECTS

WHEREAS, RA 7638 (otherwise known as the DOE Act of 1992), the Department of Energy (DOE) is mandated to devise ways and means of giving direct benefit to the province, city or municipality, especially the community and people affected and equitable preferential benefit to the region that hosts the energy resource and/or the energy-generating facility;

WHEREAS, to operationalize such mandate, the DOE issued Energy Regulation (ER) 1-94 which provides that host communities of energy generating facilities and/or energy resource developers are entitled to a share of one centavo per kilowatt-hour of the total electricity sales as financial benefit of the host community;

WHEREAS, there is a need to provide immediate financial assistance to the Host LGUs to enhance their health service and at the same time temper the socio-economic impact of the crisis and the ER 1-94. Funds are deemed to be viable, doable and readily available source of funding to empower Host LGUs to help the National Government to combat, before it is too late, COVID-19 which has continuously taken a heavy toll on lives, disrupting the way of life of the Filipino people;
