**A RESOLUTION OF RE-COMMITMENT TO STABLE INTERNAL  
PEACE AND SECURITY IN BATANGAS CITY**

**WHEREAS**, on June 10, 2025, the City Government of Batangas entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with the 59<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion, 2<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Division, Philippine Army, the Batangas Component City Police Station, Batangas Police Provincial Office, Police Regional Office IV-A (CALABARZON), and the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Regional Office IV-A, for purposes of strengthening inter-agency collaboration to ensure the continued success of law enforcement operations within Batangas City;

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement seeks to maintain and sustain the city’s status under the Seal of Internal Peace and Security (SIPS) Program, an institutional mechanism to recognize local government units that have effectively insulated their communities from threat posed by lawless elements, particularly insurgency and terrorism;

**WHEREAS**, the Stable Internal Peace and Security (SIPS) Program is a comprehensive initiative that aims to strengthen law enforcement, enhance public safety, and promote community participation in maintaining order and harmony;
